

AWARD DESCRIPTION

The scholarship is a one-time award of a \$3,000 given to 3 recipients. The award will be paid in a lump sum directly to each of the 3 recipients.

Qualifications:

- i. Douglas County, Colorado resident
- ii. High School Senior

Selection Process:

- i. 50% - Essay
- ii. 25% - Extra-curricular and community activities
- iii. 25% - GPA and ACT or SAT Scores

Application package should include:

- i. Completed application on back of this brochure
- ii. High School transcript
- iii. 2 personal letters of recommendation stating leadership, personality and character
- iv. 1 school letter of recommendation stating leadership, personality and character.
- v. Essay on *"Who, or what series of events, influenced my life and the decisions that I make and how I plan to influence other people in my life."*
- vi. All materials are to be completed and returned to the following address by May 1st.

- vii. Selection committee—The selection committee shall consist of the board of directors for the Foundation. The committee will review all the applications prior to May 31st and select 3 winners. 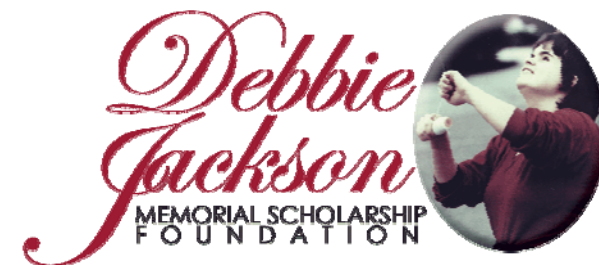
