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Thank you for your interest in hosting your golf event at Red Rocks Country Club. We look forward to providing you with a first class experience and are confident that your patrons will have a memorable day. From the beginning stages of the contractual process to the conclusion of your tournament, we ensure that you and your guests are treated to a memorable experience at Red Rocks Country Club.

The Course:

Red Rocks Country Club boasts an 18-hole championship golf course with a challenging layout and stunning views. We offer six sets of tees to accommodate golfers of all abilities. The forward tees play at 4,885 yards, while the championship tees stretch the course out to over 6,800 yards. Golfers encounter a nice variety of holes from a long, up-hill par 4 (hole #13) to a short yet narrow par 4 requiring precise shot placement (hole #5). The course plays at to a par of 71.

Golfers will enjoy the front nine and be awed by the back nine. As golfers approach the 16th, the course's signature hole, they will experience a beautiful red rock formation that serves as a backdrop to the green. This huge outcropping, shaped like a whale rising out of the ocean, is truly a natural wonder. Golfers then progress to the tee box of hole # 17, the highest point on the golf course. From here players will observe magnificent views of downtown Denver and, on a clear day, scan all the way out to Denver International Airport located some 40 miles away!



The Facility:

Set against the stunning backdrop of the massive red rock formations jutting out of the Rocky Mountain foothills, matched with panoramic views of the Denver skyline, Red Rocks Country Club offers a golf experience unlike any other. The clubhouse at Red Rocks Country Club is the perfect place to hold your outing.



You may choose to hold your continental breakfast, awards luncheon, or dinner in our outdoor covered pavilion with an adjacent patio that overlooks the lake and the famous Red Rocks Amphitheater. If you prefer, you may opt to hold your gathering inside our beautiful clubhouse dining room with wrap around patio and gorgeous views.

Formats your patrons will enjoy:

Scramble:

- This is a 4 person team event
 - Each player tees off on each hole. The best of the tee shots is selected and all players play their second shots from that spot. The best of the second shots is determined, then all play their third shots from that spot, and so on until the ball is holed.

Shamble:

- This is a 4 person or 2 person team event
 - Each player tees off on each hole. The best of the tee shots is selected and both players play their own ball until they have holed out.
 - The 1 or 2 best scores is selected to count as the team score for each hole.

Las Vegas Scramble:

- The Las Vegas Scramble is a variation of a regular scramble that involves the use of a 6-sided die
 - Scorecard will list players in order of 1,2,3,4. First name on card is player #1 etc.
 - **At each tee, all four members tee off, then the 6-sided die is thrown or rolled.** Check the number that comes up on the die. If it is a 1, 2, 3 or 4, then the drive of the team member whose number matches must be used on that hole. (Example: On the first hole, all four team members hit drives. Then the number 3 is rolled. The drive hit by the team member who is listed 3rd on the score card is the drive that must be played on this hole.)
 - If the die comes up 5 or 6, then the team can choose the best drive among the four.
 - Whether the die chooses your drive for you (rolling 1 through 4), or allows the team to choose the next drive (rolling 5 or 6), the hole is then played out as a normal 4 person scramble.



Additional Fundraising Opportunities:

Sponsor Sinage:

- Your Tournament Committee may choose to have signs made and sell sponsorship for each hole. Our Staff can easily assist you with setting out signs on every tee box prior to your event's shotgun start.

Mulligans:

- At registration each team has the opportunity to purchase a mulligan or “do-over” for a price selected by the Tournament Committee. The Committee may want to limit how many mulligans each team may use.

Deduction of Strokes:

- At registration each team has the opportunity to purchase a deduction from their final score for a fee selected by the Tournament Committee.

Professional Drive Hole:

- Red Rocks Country Club will have a Professional Hit a Drive on a golf hole, and The Tournament Committee may charge a fee for each team to use the professional's drive on the selected hole.

Length of String:

- At registration each team has the opportunity to purchase a length of string for a price selected by the Tournament Committee. When the team's ball is within the string's distance to the hole, the stroke will not be counted towards the team's score for that hole.

Putting Contest:

- The Tournament Committee may set up a putting contest to raise additional funds on the putting green at Red Rocks Country Club, as your event players come from the 18th green to the 1st tee.

Event Policies:

- A tournament date is not guaranteed until a signed contract and a \$1,000 deposit are on file at Red Rocks Country Club. The final balance will be due on the day of the event.
- The tournament chairperson guarantees, and will be legally obligated for payment of all fees for the guaranteed number of participants, and any other related charges.
- A typed and final pairing sheet is due to the professional golf staff no later than 3 business days prior to the event. An estimate of players is due 1 week prior to the event for additional carts.
- Sponsor signs must be delivered to Red Rocks Country Club, completely assembled, at least 2 hours prior to the event. RRCC golf staff will provide placement of all signage on requested holes.
- Dress code for the course and club will be enforced. Proper golf attire is required on the course and in the Clubhouse. **No denim jeans or no cut offs and collared shirts only.**
- Food and beverages must be purchased from RRCC. No outside food or beverages are permitted without authorization from Food and Beverage Director prior to the event. This includes, but is not limited to alcoholic beverages, soft drinks, sport drinks, bottled water, tobacco products, snacks, candy, etc.
- Tax-exempt status – if your tournament group qualifies for tax exemption, the organization must supply a copy of their State of Colorado Tax Exemption Certificate. It must be on file no later than two weeks before the tournament date. If no certificate is filed with RRCC, we are required to charge sales tax to your group charges, and you may request reimbursement from the State.
- If playing conditions require cancellation of the event, the tournament will be rescheduled subject to availability. In the event that the course determines that a “rain-out” has occurred before or during the event, a refund of fees, or a percentage based on the amount of play, will be made.



Event Policies Continued:

- The tournament group and chairperson are liable for proper conduct, and damages incurred by event participants. Any damage will result in the tournament group and chairperson being billed for expenses incurred by Red Rocks Country Club or third parties. The damage deposit will be returned within one month if it is determined that no additional damages were incurred during the event.
- Tournament groups will be required to provide comprehensive general liability insurance coverage for the tournament, or sign an Indemnify Waiver prior to the event. The tournament group and/or chairperson agree to indemnify and hold Red Rocks Country Club harmless from all damages.
- Tournament dates are not secure until a signed Confirmation Agreement and a deposit are received at Red Rocks Country Club.
