NO GPA REQUIREMENT

The Debbie Jackson Memorial Scholarship was originally created in 1986 by Bunny and Wayne Jackson in memory of their daughter, Debbie, who died in 1985 after a long and courageous battle with cancer at the age of 24. Debbie was diagnosed with cancer when she was a senior at Columbine High School in Littleton. In 2005, the Debbie Jackson Memorial Scholarship Foundation ("DJMSF"), a 501(c)(3) charitable organization, was created to partially support the original scholarship that was given out at Columbine United Church in Debbie's memory. That same year, the DJMSF Board elected to fund two (2) additional scholarships for Douglas County students under its own sponsorship. In 2007, the DJMSF Board voted to remove the scholarship support to Columbine United Church and increase the amount of the DJMSF sponsored scholarships to \$2,500. Later in 2007, the DJMSF Board voted to increase the amount of the DJMSF scholarships to \$3,000 and give the DJMSF Board the discretion to offer a third scholarship.

Since inception, these scholarships have helped students offset a portion of the costs associated with achieving a higher education. In 2016, the DJMSF Board voted to enlarge the DJMSF to include the recognition of Darrell Pridemore, a long-time resident and business owner in Parker, CO as well as a devoted husband and father who also confronted a battle with cancer until his death in 2016. In light of these considerations, the DJMSF Board elected to change the name of the foundation to the "Debbie Jackson & Darrell Pridemore Memorial Scholarship Foundation". In 2016, the DJMSF Board elected to add three (3) additional board members from the Pridemore family, to wit: Al Pridemore, Dwight Pridemore & Vince Pridemore. The DJMSF Board is honored and privileged to have members of the Pridemore family serve in our continuing mission to help students in our community with aspirations of a higher education.
